

# Downtown Brooklyn Neighborhood Alliance Community Events Program

## FAQ Sheet

Q: What are the rates for each of the spaces at Barclays Center?

A: The rates vary depending on the space you select and the type of program/event you want to have. For example, non-catered programs are obviously less expensive than catered events because of the catering costs. Also, if you are having an event on a day when the arena is already open, it will cost less than if the arena has to be opened for your event alone.

Q: Is the rate based on a sliding scale? What is that scale and how is it measured?

A: There's no sliding scale for space rental fees, but fees are heavily discounted. Other event costs (catering, union & staff costs, etc.) will depend on what is necessary to support the type and size of your event.

Q: What is the schedule after you submit an application for use of the space? A week? A month? Next year?

A: The event space drawing will be held on June 15, 2014. Dates for events will begin in September 2014.

Q: What are the availability dates of the spaces?

A: The availability dates of the spaces are varied. We will work with you to fit it into the Barclays Center's schedule. We want to get a date that works for you and for Barclays.

Q: How often and when are these drawings?

A: The drawing is held once a year. Check back for the date of this year's drawing

Q: Should organizations already have an event in mind when they apply?

A: It is helpful if you already have an event in mind. But if you win the drawing, our team will work with you to help you develop an event idea that works for your organization and for Barclays.

Q: How many are chosen?

A: Nine community groups will be chosen.

Q: If the Drawing winners need the facility on the same date, will you make them choose, flip a coin, or redraw?

A: We will figure out a way to break the tie with something impartial.

Flipping a coin actually sounds like a good idea.

Q: If it ends up being too much for a non-profit (after negotiations) to hold an event, do you hold a new drawing for another organization to take its place?

A: Exactly!

Q: Can we collaborate with other organizations to hold an event at the Barclays Center?

A: Yes, an organization can collaborate with other organizations.
